

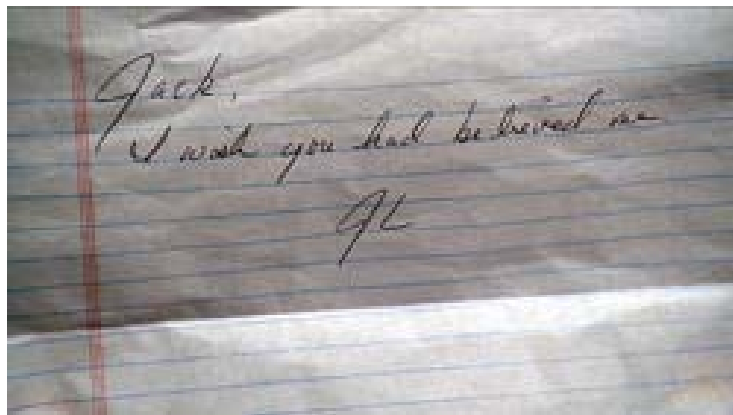
## LOST

### SEASON 6 – EPISODE 14

#### **TITLE: The Candidate**
